The University of California's financial aid programs are designed to make a UC education accessible to students at every income level. For California residents, the cost of attendance - which includes in-state tuition and fees, room and board, books and supplies, transportation, and other expenses – is fully covered through a combination of the federal Parent Contribution (for dependent students), a student self-help contribution, and grants and scholarships. Under the Blue and Gold Opportunity Plan, undergraduates with parent incomes up to \$70,000 who meet other eligibility requirements receive grants or scholarships to cover instate tuition and systemwide fees. Many students receive grants to help cover costs in addition to tuition and fees, and many students with parent incomes above \$70,000 also qualify for financial aid.
