2023 Housing Experience Survey Report - All Students Prepared by IRDS Last updated: April 26, 2023

Administration and Response Rate: The survey was administered between February 6 and February 20, 2023 to all students who live in campus sponsored housing. Student employees who are compensated with room/board were not included. Of the 3,829 students invited to complete the survey 719 (19%) provided complete or partial (i.e., answered at least one question) responses. Because students could choose whether or not to answer particular questions, the response rates varied by question. Unless otherwise noted, all respondents could answer a particular question.

Respondent Characteristics: Please refer to Tables 1-3 below for respondent characteristics, including information about the representativeness of the respondent sample relative to the invitee population. The respondent sample was roughly representative of the invitee population with a few exceptions, noted below. Note that percents should be interpreted with caution when there are small cell sizes.

- Females were more likely to respond (21%) compared to males (16%; Table 1), which is typical in survey research.
- There were also some differences across residence halls (Table 3) that should be examined by Housing and Residence Education staff to determine representativeness as well as to suggest residence halls where survey promotion efforts could be strengthened for the next survey administration.
















Which of the following experiences have you participated in? (Please select all that apply)


How do you learn about campus events, programs and activities? (Please select all that apply)







Do you park a motor vehicle on campus?






When do you need to ride CatTracks? (select all that apply)


