## 2014 New Student Survey Report

Last Updated: January 27, 2015

Prepared by Institutional Research and Decision Support

**Survey Administration:** The survey was administered between November 10, 2014 and December 14, 2014. All new undergraduate students, including first time-freshmen and transfer students, were invited to complete the survey. The survey was revised in 2014 to focus on student educational plans, transition to college life, and utilization of services provided by UC Merced. In addition, this year the survey was administered after mid-semester grades were released. In previous years, the survey closed before students received their mid-semester grades.

**Response rate:** Of the 1659 students invited to participate, 601 (36%) started but may not have completed the survey and 534 (32%) completed the survey. Because students could choose not to answer particular items, response rates for individual items varied.

**Student characteristics:** Please refer to the table below. The students who responded to the survey appear to be roughly representative of the first-year students on campus (i.e., the invitees) with regard to background and demographic characteristics. However, we did note that females were more likely to respond to the survey than males. Additionally, more transfer students responded to the survey than we would have expected.





**When you arrived at UC Merced, how welcoming did you find the campus environment?**



## Today, how connected to or disconnected from UC Merced do you feel?






## What is the highest degree you intend to eventually obtain?




## 8 What do you think your final course grades will be this semester?




11 How often have you connected with each of the following UC Merced campus resources this semester?


Have you received emails from the Students First Center regarding the UC Merced resources that are available to you?

**Have you found these emails from the Students First Center helpful?**



Please indicate your agreement with the following statements about your experience so far living in a residence hall on campus.










## Did you attend the following welcome and social activities at UC Merced?

To what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements about Summer Orientation?






