Q1 What is the UC Merced Alumni Journey Survey?

The UC Merced Alumni Journey survey is an online survey administered every other summer to graduates who received a baccalaureate degree and who are 1, 3, and 5 years post-graduation. The survey asks about several topics, including:

- Your current contact information and how you like to receive news about UC Merced;
- Your current employment and other education you pursued, including how well UC Merced prepared you;
- Your engagement in volunteer and outreach activities; and
- Your interest in being engaged with the campus as an alumni (e.g., helping enrich the student experience)

We know that the COVID-19 pandemic has made this year both unusual and challenging. The pandemic has created uncertainty and stress for many. We will first ask you several questions about how the pandemic has impacted you. Because we administer this survey on a fixed schedule every other year, we will then ask the typical survey questions. This will help us understand differences between responses this year and prior years.

We recognize that some questions on the survey may be stressful to answer at this time, particularly those about employment. But we hope you will consider taking the survey to help UC Merced better understand how the pandemic has impacted our alumni and how we can support you during these challenging times.

Accessibility

If you are using screen reading software (e.g., JAWS), please use table navigation. You are also encouraged to email or call UC Merced Accessibility Services – access@ucmerced.edu or 209-228-6996 - for assistance. **We recommend that you use a computer/laptop or tablet device to take the survey. Some of the questions may not display properly on a phone.** The survey will be available between May 26th to August 14th, 2020. Note that you do not have to complete the survey in one sitting; depending on your browser settings, your responses will be saved as you progress.

Study Procedure

If you agree to participate, you should be able to complete the survey in 10-15 minutes. The main purpose of this survey project is to gather your input on your time at UC Merced, your

post-graduate career and educational pursuits, and your relationship with UC Merced as an alum. We appreciate your participation and will use the survey results to evaluate and improve our academic and co-curricular programs, our services, and our communication with UC Merced alumni. The design of the study requires that we also obtain background information about you from official campus records. This includes but is not limited to your degree major, year you graduated, gender, and race and ethnicity.

Prizes

In appreciation for your time and as an incentive for taking the survey, we will give away 40 \$25 Amazon e-gift cards – a total of \$1,000. Survey completers will be entered into bi-weekly gift card drawings, so the earlier you complete the survey the more chances you'll have to win! The exact odds of winning a prize are unknown, as this is influenced by the number of people who complete and submit a survey. However, the approximate odds of winning any prize based on past response rates and the number of available prizes is 1/20. UC Merced Alumni Relations will notify winners about how to claim their prize at the email address they used to take the survey.

Voluntary Participation

Participation in this survey is entirely voluntary. Your decision whether or not to participate in the survey will not affect your relationship with UC Merced or benefits to which you may otherwise be entitled. You may choose to withdraw at any time without penalty. You may also choose not to answer particular questions and still be eligible for prizes.

Benefits

While there may not be any direct benefit to you from participating, the survey gives graduates an opportunity to comment on the quality of the education they received, student services, and other aspects of their undergraduate experience that help the University evaluate and improve undergraduate programs and services. This information can also help us understand how best to contact, engage, and support our alumni.

With appropriate Institutional Review Board (IRB) approval, the data may also be used in anonymized form for academic research.

Protecting your privacy

Survey responses will be matched against student background information such as your degree major, the year you graduated, etc., for aggregation and reporting purposes. Data that can identify you individually includes your Student ID, name, and email address. Information that can identify you is used for the purposes of emailing survey invitations and reminders. Please be assured that your identity will not be connected to your survey responses unless otherwise indicated in the survey and unless we have your consent. In general, your responses

will be confidential and the results of the study will be reported only as aggregate (group level) data. Any identifiable information that is obtained in connection with this study will remain confidential and will be disclosed only with your permission or as required by law. In particular, there are areas in the survey that will ask you whether it is okay to share survey responses and identifying information with appropriate campus offices (e.g., Alumni Relations, the Center for Career and Professional Advancement, Admissions). This information will not be shared in a way that could identify you unless you indicate that we have your permission to do so. Any quotations from responses to open ended questions used in public reporting will be reviewed to ensure that your identity cannot be ascertained unless you give us permission to identify you.


